



## Equine Care Specialist

### Qualifications:

- Knowledgeable in all aspects of horse care
- Upbeat, dynamic personality
- Team player capable of working independently and taking ownership of responsibilities

### Duties:

- Take care of all horses and barns
- Complete daily, weekly, and monthly checklists which include the following:
  - Feed, grain, and hay three to four times daily as scheduled.
  - Check, scrub, and refill water troughs and automatic waterers daily
  - Clean and re-bed sheds
  - Pick paddocks and pastures, and rake old hay
  - Scrub feed buckets
  - Throw down hay from the loft as needed
  - Change blankets and fly masks as needed
  - Clean stalls and prepare stalls for horses coming in for lessons
  - Sweep barns as needed
  - Bring horses in and prepare them for lessons
  - Delegate tasks for barn volunteers/grooms and help manage workgroups
  - Work with the Facility Team to keep barns and equipment in good working order
