Duties:

Take care of all horses and barns

Complete daily, weekly and monthly check lists which include the following:

- Feed, grain and hay three to four times daily as scheduled.
- Check, scrub and refill water troughs and automatic waterers daily.
- Clean and re-bed sheds.
- Pick paddocks, pastures and rake old hay.
- Scrub feed buckets.
- Throw down hay from loft as needed.
- Change blankets and fly masks as needed.
- Clean stalls and prepare stalls for horses coming in for lessons.
- Sweep barns as needed.
- Bring horses in and prepare them for lessons.
- Delegate tasks for barn volunteers/grooms and help manage work groups.
- Work with Facility Team to keep barns and equipment in good working order.
