#### Alongside the Facility Director and Facility Volunteers:

#### Maintain Safety and Cleanliness of Farm, House and Grounds

- Keep farm facilities clean, safe, and in good working order.
- Keep house clean, safe, and in good working order.
- Keep hay barn clean, safe, and in good working order.
- Keep classroom and other North Barn common areas clean, safe, and in good working order.
- Remove trash weekly.
- Assist with mowing, snow removal, salting, and similar tasks.

### Maintain Safety and Cleanliness of Horse Facilities

- Keep pastures free of poop using poop sweeper.
- Keep pastures properly mown and free of weeds and foreign objects.
- Ensure fence and gate integrity.
- Maintain sheds, automatic waterers and troughs.
- Maintain arenas and round pen.

#### Other Responsibilities

- Apply Volunteer Resources. Coordinate with supervisor, colleagues, and Volunteer
  management team to train, assign, and supervise volunteers to and on needs as
  appropriate. Maintain inventory and schedule of tasks that can be performed by
  individual volunteers as appropriate and by scheduled work groups.
- Support Team Members and Colleagues. Assist supervisor and colleagues with related projects as requested.
